

# N° 18457 THE PLURALISTIC SOLOTON-ORCHESTRA (2021)

Art Association Bochum / Kemnade klingt - Current positions in sound art


To realize this project, I was given instruments from the Hans and Hede Grumbt collection, which is kept in the musical instrument museum Haus Kemnade in Bochum.

Each key of the piano is assigned a specific sound of a musical instrument. For example a javanese gong, an african balafon, gamelan instruments, various drums, cymbals, bells made of wood or metal, a bone chain, a kalimba, and a wide variety of stringed instruments are used.

The diverse, pluralistic orchestra can be controlled centrally via the piano using cord connections. Each musical instrument involved is limited to a monotonous sound when it is struck with a small piano hammer. But they can played together and a many-voiced edifice of sound can be created.









## N° 18907 - THE FOUND MUSIC ORCHESTRA (2023)

Project scholarship for art communication at the DA Kunsthaus Kloster Gravenhorst

The Found Music Orchestra is a participatory project that run for one year. There is a studio in the Kunsthaus that Albrecht Fersch has equipped with materials, tools and ideas.

It is open for participants who want to carry out sound experiments, construct musical instruments and use them to produce music together with the artist in this workshop. The main focus is on a donated grand piano, which can be prepared in the spirit of John Cage.

The project takes place as part of the one-year project scholarship at the Kunsthaus Kloster Gravenhorst. The process is open-ended and also depends on the participants.

# N° 18154 - TYPOPHONE (2020)

typewriter / 44 connected keys / booth equipped with sound objects L120cm x W79cm x H180cm

Created after a typewriter and a guitar came together on my workbench. Built during an intensive four-week scholarship in the water tower of Geldern.

A cabin and a small desk with an integrated typewriter.

Using the typewriter keys, 44 sound objects can be set in motion by impact or friction. The person playing sits inside the sound capsule and is enveloped by the sounds she have produced herself, by the music of letters. The typophone is a total work of art that unites literature, music, poetry, handicraft and visual arts in one installation.


The body of a discarded harmonium, a keyboard with 49 keys and associated sound objects.














About  $60\text{m}^3$  of sand was distributed on a paved square and a beach atmosphere was created in the middle of the surrounding sea of houses with sun loungers, parasols and a bottle post office. The fountain sculpture in the middle of the square was encased (timber and cement fiber boards - height 5m and  $\varnothing$  3m).

During the 6 weeks of the project, I lived in a trailer on the edge of the island. During this time I inscribed the entire column with thoughts about vacation, work, society, living conditions on islands and in cities and every now and then I wrote one of the stranded thoughts in the sand of the island.

A project within the "XXXI. Greizer Theaterherbst" - a two month workshop





N° 18845 - RandoMotoRandom (2022)

4 remote-controlled vehicles - 20 tubular bells - a playing area of 5m x 6m Sound installation for the Localize Festival for City, Culture and Art / ÜBERN BERG in Potsdam

4 remote controls on narrow platforms are ready for visitors. Small, springy metal mallets are attached to the top of the vehicles, with which the tubular bells, which are all hanging at the same height, can be struck. After a bit of practice, you will be able to do this in a more targeted manner. With the mix of mini bumper cars and pinball machines, an electro-motorized random concert is created.

N° 16927 - GEFÜGE (EDIFICE) (2017) Installation made of plastic foils, Length: 9 meter, received the art prize of the Garden Show Wassertrüdingen Large photo: during "aquamediale" / Lübben 2017 small photo above: Art and lace in dialogue - Lace Museum Abenberg 2019 - small photo below: Garden Show Wassertrüdingen 2019

An organic material imitating life and integrating into nature by formal resemblance. The artificial is pretending to be vivid and vital. The installation has no solid shape, it is smooth and flexible, it yields when it is pushed. It reminds to a huge oversized spider web. Maybe it stretches here across the water because it intends to catch something essential for existence in order to get spirited and come to life.

But first of all it lives in the imagination of the spectators. They can follow the plastic cords with their eyes and discover musical lines, interwoven together like the multiple scores of a fugue.

## N° 17684 - TAM-TAM-TRUNK (2019)

Wood sculptor symposium at Riedelhof / Vogtland

A spruce trunk, 2 meters long and 70cm in diameter, was debarked, hollowed out and planed smooth during the two-week symposium. Wires and round rods made of thick aluminum, galvanized iron and spring steel were bent into spirals and

manufactured compression springs. The metal elements of the instrument can be played with various mallets made of wood, felt, rubber or with thin threaded rods.

## N° 17355 - THE DRIPPING ORCHESTRA (2018)

Installation in a former station hall during the Wunsiedler Water Games / Wunsiedel

From a tube system below the ceiling water drips out of 25 points at different speeds. In some places, the drops fall directly on sounding bodies such as tin box, wine glass, can, plastic canister, percussion basin, plastic bottle, tambourine clamp, bell of an alarm clock. On other objects - e.g. guitar, violin, tambourine, triangle, wire mesh or resonance box - there are metal plates attached, which are set in vibration by the impinging drops and thereby make the respective instrument to sound. Visitors can move in space and intervene in the sound sequences by catching individual drops.

N° 16553 - MURMURATION (2016)

I decomposed a complete piano with its 88 keys and created new instruments by installing the mechanics of the piano on 30 wooden planks. They are each 3 m long and spread out in the church. With the piano keys you can play now on buckets, long wires, saw blades, pots and pans, bells, gongs and so on. The visitors of the festival "The Blue Night" were allowed to play on these instruments and a randomly and loud concert arosed.



N° 16958 - THE WELL DISMANTLED PIANO (2017)

Sound Installation during the Schlossmediale - Castle of Werdenberg / Switzerland

Some of the piano keys were removed from the piano and were combined with sound objects which are spread in the room. The keys which stayed in the piano were linked with pots, pans, dishes, tins, wooden boxes, a drying rack, bells, milk cans etc. All these objects were hit by the small piano hammers which were pulled by strings.

The piano turns into a techno machine. During the festival there were several performances and the visitors were also allowed to try out the instrument.

### N° 17804 - GONG TO GO

30 hanging objects on a framework of white wooden slats - 6m x 3m - height: 2.40m Schöneweide industrial salon / Berlin

8 white construction helmets are ready. A mallet is attached to each of them, which consists of a wooden ball on a flexible wire. Visitors of the exhibition can choose a helmet that matches their body size so that when they run through the installation, their mallets can reach the hanging objects. When several people start walking around the room, they tap with the mallets - occasionally, sometimes deliberately - against pots, buckets, pitchers, lampshades, spoons, strainers or a vanity case. The result is a concert that can hardly be controlled.













N° 17824 KILLER-KALIMBA (2019)

20 sounding knife blades L 75cm x W 45cm x H 60cm

A wooden table on which sharp knives are attached. There are a number of ways to play the killer-kalimba: with wooden or felt mallets. Just like a real kalimba, it can also be plucked with your fingers. The arrangement of the blades was determined not by chromatic, but above all by visual aspects.



# N° 16612 - DIN GRINDER (2016)

height of tripod: 93cm - height with objects 134cm - complete Ø127cm built for solo exhibition in "Fischmüller's Cabinet for Extraordinary Experiences" in Freiburg

The inner wheel can come to rotation by manual operation. Thereby the 12 objects get banged by a mallet. Bottle, bell, cake-pan, bicycle basket, shovel etc. result in a deafening noise.

# N° 17512 THE BOTTLE PIANO (2018)

The bottle piano consists of 25 cut bottles, arranged in two chromatic scales. This means that the pitch levels are not set with different water fillings, as you might expect, but they are fixed.

Each bottle is played with a hammer. By means of the self-built keyboard and a connected wire string system, the hammers can be moved.

## N° 17304 - CATCH AND RELEASE (2018)

Performance for the Urbs Art Festival Concreta Festapoesia of the Accademia d'Ungheria / Hungarian Academy of Culture in Rome

In the course of my life I repeatedly came across insights, aphorisms, pearls of wisdom that seemed important to me, that had a direct, personal meaning for my life at that moment and beyond. I have collected these sentences and now they are handwritten on 387 silver pieces of paper on my costume. On the one hand, there are traces that I leave behind in the past, because the sentences hit me or they formed in me at certain moments, when I thought I understood something or thought I saw an important lesson in them. On the other hand, there are also guidelines that point to the future. Some find confirmation every now and then, others prove pointless or outdated and should be corrected.

Clothed with these essential sentences, I become a pictorial vessel for the wisdom of my life so far. Equipped in this way, I go among people, expose myself to the strangeness that surrounds me. An exchange should take place between one's own knowledge and that of others, an interpersonal transfusion of wisdom-containing juices. You can take out a piece of paper (silver paper) at random - pick a poem from my costume - and refill the empty, transparent bag with your own written wisdom (white paper), which comes spontaneously in your mind.

When confronted with other people's opinions in a new, unfamiliar environment, I test my own opinions. Give them away, my own points of view, the curdled insights, release the caught fish and wait for what new may come my way. As the performance progresses, I get whiter and whiter.











## NEST (2008/11)

gallery "18m" in 2008 / Berlin during the Ostrale in 2011 / Dresden Walk-in Cube, measuring 2,20m x 2,20m x

Outside it is build with all kinds of wood I have found in the streets of Berlin. The interior is plastered all over the walls and ceiling with countless pictures, photographs, drawings and newspaper clippings.

You ars surrounded by webs, mazes, messes, tangles, branches, veins, networks, crossroads, knots, threads, nests, meshes, accumulations, patterns, intertwinings, hairs, connections, tubes and so on.

A visual sweat lodge, a heat machine, lit only by a naked light bulb.
